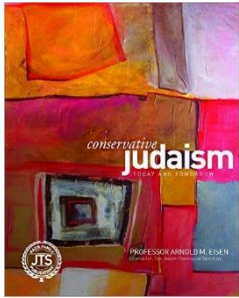


Make Judaism Come Alive through Learning at NSJC's Jewish University
